## A Practical Approach to Transformation



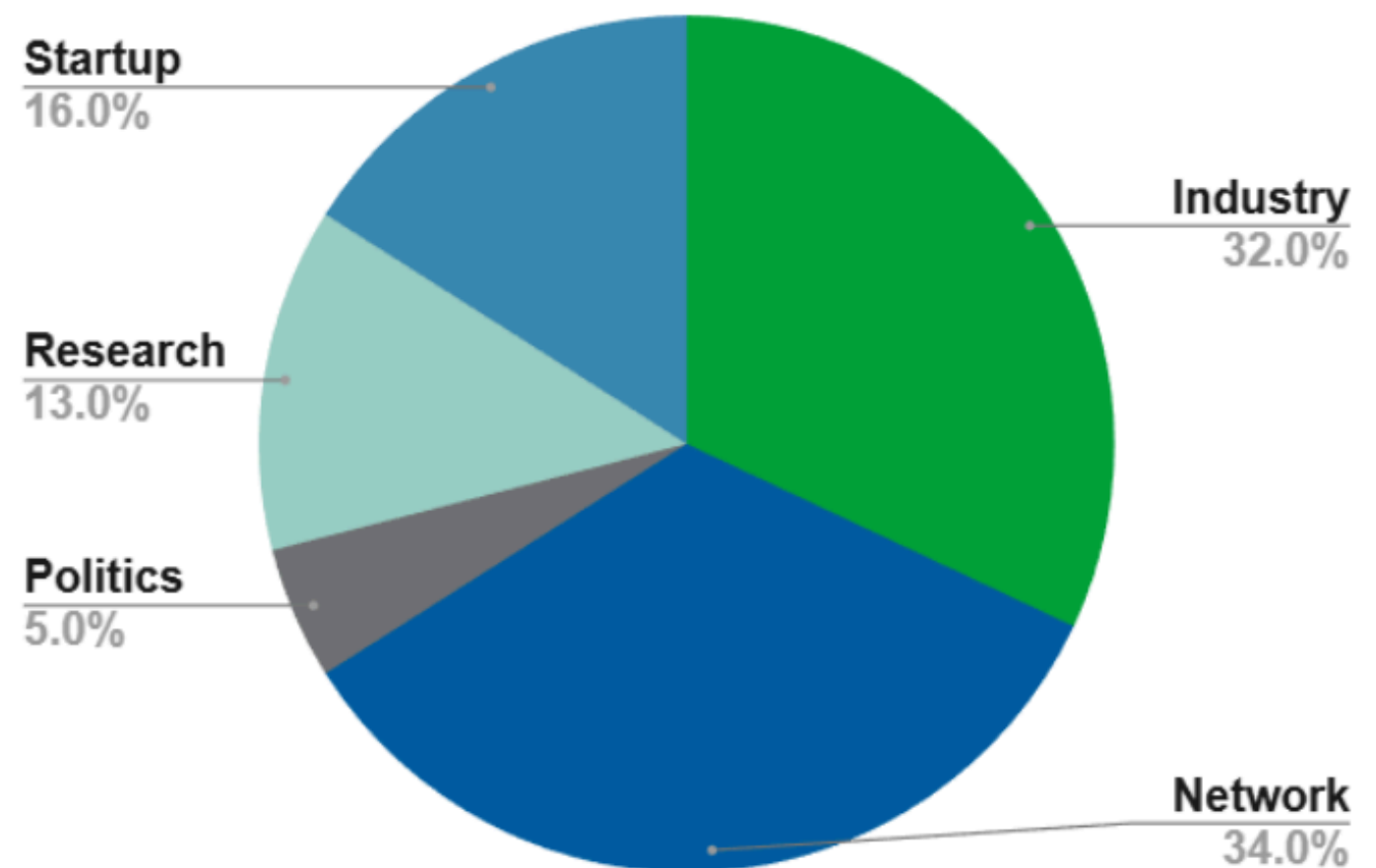
On August 26th, the **RootCamp office in Hannover** became the meeting point for thought leaders, innovators, and policymakers shaping the bioeconomy. **Nexus Bioeconomy 2025 brought together experts from industry, science, startups, and government** to discuss one central question: How do we make the shift to a truly sustainable bioeconomy?

Discussions highlighted the need for **stronger collaboration across sectors** and clearer **political frameworks** to overcome fragmented regulation. Speakers called for a cohesive **"lighthouse strategy"** to guide transformation and emphasized the importance of **regional initiatives** and innovation networks.

There was an atmosphere of collaboration, encouraged by the **interactive breakout sessions**, in which attendees actively worked towards solutions within the bioeconomy. Throughout the day, one message stood out: **the bioeconomy is already in motion** — but its **success depends on coordination, innovation, and communication** among all stakeholders.
